part of. You alone I worship; guide me in Your Way. You, LORD are merciful and compassionate, slow to anger and abounding in unfailing love. You shower compassion on all You created. Thank You for today. Keep my home safe through this night. Tomorrow, my plans include *list your planned chores, places you'll go, people you'll see.* Please

keep Your hand on everything I do, that I may not hurt anyone. I love You. Amen.
