John 4:5-42 – Jesus and the Woman of Samaria

Day 1

John 4:5-15
What is “living water” in your faith? What keeps your spirit alive in God’s word? What things quench your thirst for a moment but leave you thirsty in the end?

Day 2

John 4:16-26
Can you imagine meeting Jesus like this? What would it be like to hear a stranger tell you about your life in this way? Would you believe that it was Jesus, or would you think that it was some sort of trick?

Day 3

John 4:27-30
Tell about a time when someone asked you to come see something or someone amazing (not a Youtube video, something in person!) What did it take to convince you to go?

Day 4

John 4:31-38
How is this passage different from spreading God’s word? Do you think it is easier to tell the stories (sow the seeds of faith) or to gather the believers together (reap the harvest)?

Day 5

John 4:38-42
Why do you believe in Christ? Was it someone else’s story about their faith? Or something that you experienced? Tell a story that helped to shape your faith.
